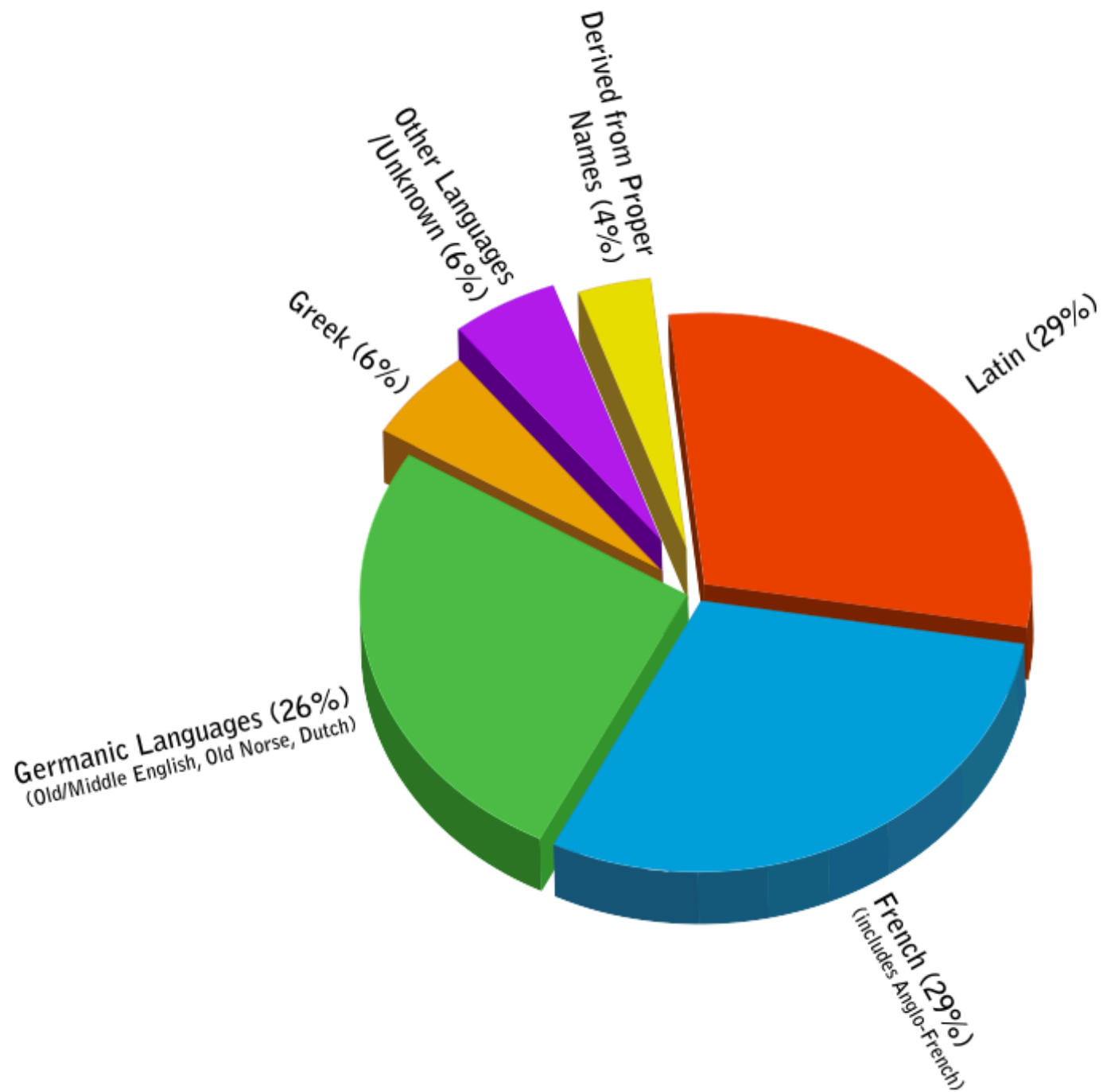

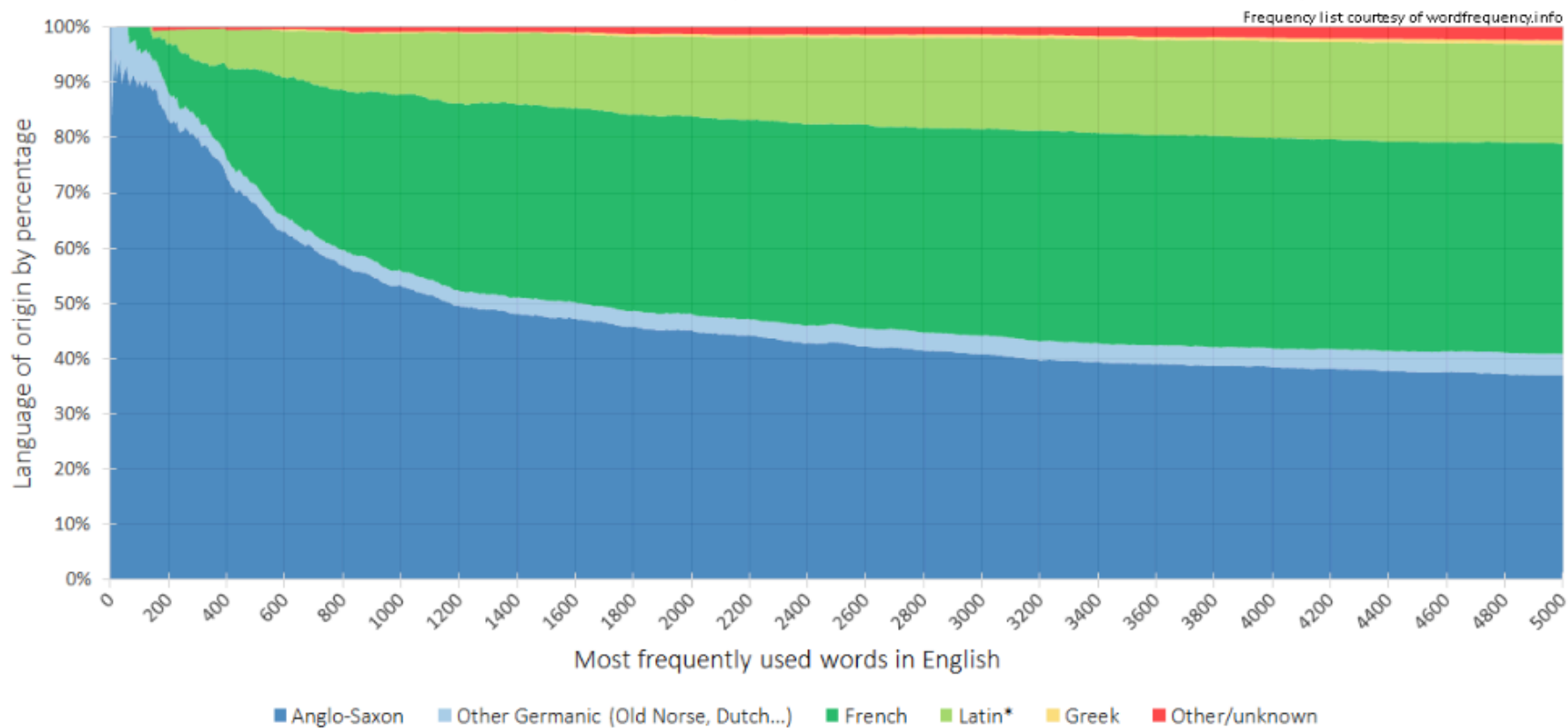

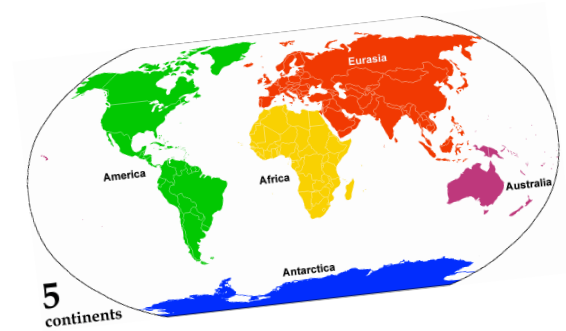
## Composition of modern English by languages of origin (top 2% vocabulary)
