This project is based on your choice. It may be research-based, informational, persuasive/debate, film, or narrative. It could be language, history, technology, sports, math, or science based. This project is yours. It is only limited by your imagination, your enthusiasm, and your effort.

REQUIREMENTS For the project

- You need to submit your project **proposal plan by May 4**. This document will be submitted on Google Classroom for your first grade on this project.
- ➤ You must log a minimum of 3 hours (180 minutes) on this project. There will be a weekly document in Google Classroom. You will complete this Google Doc to let me know how many minutes you have spent on the project for the week.
- ➤ If your project is hands-on, like something you make, or if the project is in stages, you need pictures or video of the progress in constructing your work.
- ➤ For your final presentation, you will also need to write at least one paragraph describing the project. However, this paragraph can be divided into illustrated slides with a sentence on each slide.
- For this required presentation, you may do slides or a video, or a mixture of both.
- ➤ If your project is writing only, it must be a minimum of a one-page informational essay, persuasive essay, or original narrative. (250 words minimum) You will still need to make a presentation of your paper even if it is you reading it or a slide presentation. This must be original. If there is any plagiarism, it will not be accepted, and it will have to be redone.
- > The **completed project will be due May 22**, but if you finish before that you will have free time at the end of the year for yourself.
